Dear Friends

We are very happy to invite you again this year, to the ninth CLRG feis in Slovakia organized by the Avalon Academy of Irish Dance, which will be held in the spring season for the fourth time. The feis is being held in the capital city Bratislava which is well connected with three other European capitals –Vienna (70km), Prague (330km) and Budapest (200km). The nearest airports are Bratislava airport (10min drive) and Vienna airport (60min drive) with regular low costs and standard flights from most of the European cities.

The venue of this years feis will be Dom kultury Vajnory located in the quiet suburb of Vajnory, offering free parking facilities in the nearby streets, a large feis hall with a 5x16m floor, results room, changing rooms, warm up area and a cafe. The feis will be run on two floors one day. We will also offer special free style treble reel on all levels, adult championships and first feis special.

There will be trophies for all first places and medals for runners up. In traditional set dances, treble reels, trophy dances, open championships, adult championships. Sashes will be awarded to the top three dancers in the championships and top dancers in the light and heavy trophies and first feis special.

Due to capacity reasons the maximum number of competitors will be 270. Entries will close after this number is reached.

We are looking forward to seeing you all in Bratislava in April and wish the very best of luck to those competing at our feis!

Entries will open 17th February 2024 and close 24th March 2024 – <u>or when the cap of 270 dancers</u> <u>is reached.</u> Late entries on the day will be allowed to already registered dancers only.

Dancers' numbers will be available for collection by teachers or school representatives - the fee for the entire school must be paid beforehand.

Rialacha NaFeis -Feis Rules

- 1. The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha.
- 2. Entries will be accepted from persons currently registered with An Coimisiún.
- 2. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
- 3. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 4. Age will be taken as on 1st January 2024. Whatever age a dancer turns this year in 2024, s/he will dance under that age all year long, e.g. if a dancer's date of birth is 29th May 2012, he/she dances under 13 in the year 2024 or 11-13). Evidence of age may be requested, therefore dancers from Mainland Europe should have a valid ID with them in the event of a query as to their age.
- 5. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
- 6. Beginners Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st 2nd or 3rd prize in any competition for that particular dance (please refer to the grid). In Beginners Grade competitions only basic steps may be performed.
- 7. Primary Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st 2nd or 3rd

prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance other than in Beginners Grade.

8. Intermediate Grade competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won 1st or 2nd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance in Intermediate under the

same or higher age limits. If a dancer in Continental Europe and Asia wins in Intermediate, they advance to the next level for the rest of the calendar year. Teachers can move dancers back at their own discretion at the start of the next calendar year.

- 9. For all Beginner, Primary, Intermediate the 32 bar method will be applied. In Beginner/Primary/Intermediate trophy competitions and first feis special 16 bars are required. All Premier Championship dancers (except adults in Adult Premier Championships and U9age group) will be required to dance 48 bars of music in the reel and jig and 40 bars in the slip-jig and hornpipe. In the adult Premier Championships and U9 premier championships dancers will be required to dance 32 bars of music in both their dances in the Round 1 and Round 2.
- 10. First Feis special is open to all dancers that have never before competed at a graded competition. All dancers will be required to dance to 16bars of music in Reel timing at beginner speed. Every dancer participating will receive an award and a small gift. This competition is for fun only and will not affect grading of the dancer.
- 11. Treble reel competition is freestyle nad the topic is The World of Animals. All dancers will be required to dance to 16bars of music in Reel timing at speed 113.
- 12. Premier Championships (for dancers of intermediate and open level) will be judged as two solos and an overall Premier Championship by one adjudicator. If there are more than 12 dancers in any competition, it will go to recall. Dancers who wish to compete in rounds only solo competitions may do so. If they do not dance a set dance they will be excluded from the Championship result, but they will be judged in the solo rounds. Round 1: choice of heavy jig or hornpipe Round 2: choice of reel or slip jig Round 3 (recall): modern set dance or traditional set dance for competition 8 and 34 only. Adult Premier Championships have been created for dancers who started Irish dancing as ADULTS.
- 13. 4/6/8 Hand ceili competitions must be performed in accordance with the An Coimisiún handbook "Ar Rinci Foirne" and are subject to the rules applied at Oireachtasi.2/3 hand competitions All dancers will be required to dance to 40 bars of music in Reel timing at open speed.
- 14. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún, the organisers may at their discretion cancel or combine competitions with insufficient entries.
- 15. Order and quiet must be kept in the hall, particularly while competitors are dancing.
- 16. Traditional Set Dance competitions are a choice out of 7 traditional dances: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Jockey to the Fair and Three Sea Captains. If a dancer wins first place in any traditional set dance competition, s/he moves on the next level in all 7 traditionals.
- 17. Provided that dancers are not disturbed by flashlights or the like, photography or video recording by persons other than official feis photographers is allowed during Beginners and Primary competitions and during all award ceremonies. During Intermediate and Premier Championships competitions, this is reserved to any official feis photographer if

present on site.

- 18. <u>Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their</u> <u>competitions are scheduled. It can happen that the competitions will start 30minutes</u> <u>ahead of scheduled time.</u>
- 19. The Feis organisers cannot accept any liability for injury or loss or damage to property while on the premises.
- 20. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions.
- 21. The dress code in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed.
- 22. All Beginners and Primary dancers of all age groups may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt and top/blouse, simple dress for girls and ladies, trousers and t-shirt/shirt for boys and gents). Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.
- 23. Costume Length: Length of costumes must adhere to principles of modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may ask a competitor to change into black tights (of a denier not less than 70 per cent) in order for the dancer to continue in the competition. When wearing body suits with skirts (commonly known as black-out attire) black tights (of a denier less than 70) must be worn. Effective date: 1st February, 2020 For details of approved costume features, please refer to the Costume Rules on www.clrg.ie.
- 24. Female Adult dancers participating in competitions entitled 'adult grade competitions' (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier no less than 70. CLRG ruling March 2015.
- 25. An Coimisiún has ruled that from 1st January each year, that **no block, en pointe,** stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. **The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.**
- 26. By entering in competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public Internet archives.
- 27. No refunds will be made unless the feis is cancelled.
- 28. Music will be played at the recognized An Coimisiún speeds of Mainland Europe.
